Developing people's life skills is an integral aspect of Learn to Earn's mission to develop people holistically. All students registered for any training at Learn to Earn will receive life skills training.

Some of the topics covered in the course are:

- Self-awareness
- Self esteem
- Family relationships
- HIV/AIDS
- Conflict resolution
- Goal Setting

An optional Discipleship programme is also offered, based on the adapted version of the Alpha Course

Following our viewpoint of 'a hand up – not a hand out' all students are required to pay towards the cost of their course at LtE. By paying a part of the fees for your training, you become a contributing partner in your development and have a greater sense of ownership in the change of your circumstances.

Entry requirements: Grade 10, and a desire to work in hospitality industry
Cost to Learn to Earn: R14 400

A Barista is a person who has the skill of making coffee using an espresso machine. They work in the hospitality industry (which could mean long hours and shift work). Areas of employment could include: coffee shops, restaurants and function venues, corporate office spaces and mobile coffee vans.
