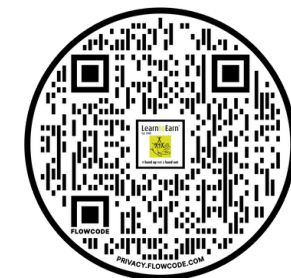

## Basic Computers

**Total Course Fee:** R400 (R300 registration fee + R100 course fee)  
**Times:** 13h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs, 13h30-15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 3 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Gr 10 pass  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R13 750

The main aim of this course is to provide basic computer literacy.

## Bake for Profit

**Total Course fee:** R800 (R300 registration fee + R500 course fee ie 2 x payments of R250)  
**Times:** Three times a week, 08h30 - 16h30  
**Duration:** 8 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Basic literacy & numeracy assessment, access to a stove.  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R17 600

This course is **designed for the course graduate to have the skills needed to run a baking business from home - including business and baking skills.**

### Modules covered include:

- Measuring techniques
- Cooking & mixing methods
- Safety & hygiene

## Ground UP Barista Course

**Total Course Fee:** R600 (R300 registration fee + R300 course fee ie 2 x payments of R150)  
2 x R150 payments course fee)  
**Times:** 08h30 - 16h00 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 8 Weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Grade 10 pass, & desire to work in hospitality industry.  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R31 500

Graduates will have a basic understanding of the coffee industry, including how to pull an espresso shot, texturize milk and understand and make different espresso-based drinks.

**A Barista** is a person who **makes coffee using an espresso machine**. They work in the hospitality industry (which could mean

## Graphic Design

**Total Course Fee:** R1500 (R300 registration fee + R1200 course fee, ie 4 x payments of R300)  
**Times:** 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 21 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** matric exemption certificate, between ages of 18-30, computer literate, complete entrance portfolio requirements.

The aim of the Graphic Design course is to bridge the gap between high school and entrance into formal tertiary education in the field of graphic design.

- Adobe Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator
- Drawing Skills

## Shop Assistant

**Total Course Fee:** R500 (R300 registration fee + R200 course fee)  
**Times:** 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 6 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Grade 12 pass, computer literate, complete the assessment.  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R32 500

This course will provide the graduate with a basic understanding of aspects of the retail industry including customer service, point of sale, online shopping basket collections, merchandising and warehousing.

## Basic Sewing

**Total Course Fee:** R900 (R300 registration fee + R600 course fee ie 3 x payments of R200)  
**Times:** 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 12 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Basic literacy & numeracy assessment, course participants will need to have a domestic sewing machine at home.  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R30 100

### Modules covered include:

- Control & threading of industrial machine & over-locker
- Sample Portfolio
- Constructing a range of items.

## Basic Handyman

**Total Course Fee:** R950 (R300 registration fee + R650 course fee ie 2 x payments of R200, 1 x payment of R250)  
**Times:** 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri  
**Duration:** 14 weeks  
**Entry requirements:** Grade 10, successfully complete theory & practical assessment, have own PPE suit and work boots.  
**Cost to Learn to Earn:** R54 600
