All students registered for any training at Learn to Earn will receive life skills training.

Some of the topics covered in the course are:

- Self-esteem
- Gender Based Violence
- Family Relationships
- Job Readiness & CV's
- Conflict Resolution
- Goal Setting

An optional Discipleship programme is also offered, based on the adapted version of the Alpha Course.

Following our viewpoint of 'a hand up – not a hand out' all students are required to pay towards the cost of their course at LtE.

By paying a part of the fees for your training, you become a contributing partner in your development and have a greater sense of ownership in the change of your circumstances.

How to Apply

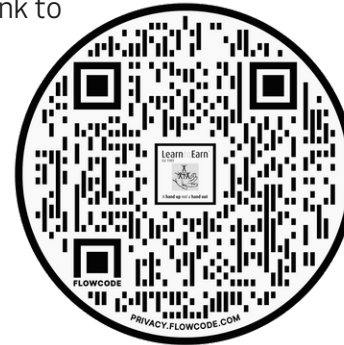

Basic Computers

Total Course Fee: R400 (R300 registration fee + R100 course fee)

Times: 1/2 day

Duration: 3 weeks

Entry requirements: Basic literacy & numeracy

Cost to Learn to Earn: R13 750

This course provides basic computer literacy.

Shop Assistant

Total Course Fee: R500 (R300 registration fee + R200 course fee ie 2 x payments of R100)

Times: 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri

Duration: 6 weeks

Entry requirements: Grade 12 pass (matric), computer literate, successfully complete the course entry assessment.

Cost to Learn to Earn: R32 500

This course will provide the graduate with a basic understanding of aspects of the retail industry including customer service, point of sale, online shopping basket collections, merchandising and warehousing.

Basic Hospitality

Total Course Fee: R900 (R300 course registration fee + R600 course fee ie 3 x payments of R200)

Times: 08h30 - 16h00 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri

Duration: 12 weeks

Entry requirements: Grade 10, strong interest in food & people, successfully complete the course entry assessment.

Cost to Learn to Earn: R41 500

Modules covered include:

- Customer Service & Role of the waiter
- Food hygiene
- Table & beverage service
- Theory & practical training in food preparation & food service
- Handling knives & chopping skills
- Cooking and baking terms
- Preparation of recipes with eggs, vegetables, fruit, herbs & spices.

Home Management

Total Course Fee: R500 (R300 registration fee + R200 course fee)

Times: 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri

Duration: 8 weeks

Entry requirements: Basic literacy & numeracy assessment

Cost to Learn to Earn: R17 000

Modules covered include:

- Cleaning Skills
- Basic Kitchen Skills
- Time Keeping Skills
- Laundry, folding & ironing
- Communication

Ground UP Barista course

Total Course Fee: R600 (R300 course registration fee + R300 course fee ie 2 x payments of R150))

Times: 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri

Duration: 8 Weeks

Entry requirements: Grade 10, and a desire to work in hospitality industry, successfully complete the course entry assessment.

Cost to Learn to Earn: R31 500

A Barista is a person who has the skill of making coffee using an espresso machine. They work in the hospitality industry (which could mean long hours and shift work). Areas of employment could include: coffee shops, restaurants and function venues, corporate office spaces and mobile coffee vans.

Bake for Profit

Total Course fee: R800 (R300 registration fee + R500 course fee ie 2 x payments of R250)

Times: Three times a week, 08h30 - 16h30

Duration: 8 weeks

Entry requirements: Basic literacy & numeracy assessment, access to stove.

Cost to Learn to Earn: R17 600

This course is designed for the course graduate to have the skills needed to run a baking business from home - including business and baking skills.

Modules covered include:

- Basic business skills – recipe costing, business plan etc
- Cooking & mixing methods
- Safety & hygiene
- Measuring techniques

Basic Handyman

Total Course fee: R950 (R300 registration fee + R650 course fee ie 2 x payments of R200, 1 x payment of R250)

Times: 08h30 - 16h30 Mon - Thurs & 08h30 - 15h30 Fri

Duration: 14 weeks

Entry requirements: Grade 10, successfully complete the course entry assessment, own PPE suit & workboots.

Cost to Learn to Earn: R54 600

Modules covered include:

- Health & Safety in the workplace
- Tool identification and correct use
- Basic Electrical skills, Basic Plumbing skills, Basic Building skills.
